



We would like to ensure you are aware of the latest developments regarding the coronavirus pandemic in Fort Worth and Tarrant County. Our Covid-19 internal protocols have been in place and already meet the requirements by the State and this County order. This new order affects all guests, and this is something we will take very seriously while making sure all of our guests still have a great experience while visiting.

Tarrant County Judge Glenn Whitley's latest executive order requires masks in all Tarrant County businesses beginning at 6 p.m. June 26th through 6 a.m. August 3rd. [Read the order here.](#)

Highlights of the order and implications for our establishment:

- Face masks will be required in all Tarrant County businesses and at outdoor gatherings with more than 100 people beginning at 6 p.m. Friday through 6 a.m. Aug. 3.
- The requirement of a face covering does not apply if covering the nose and mouth poses a significant mental or physical health risk to the individual.
- Face coverings include masks, scarves, bandanas or a handkerchief.
- While in PalmWood and Frost Tower Fort Worth, guests should wear a mask when walking in and keep it on until they are seated. Then they can take the mask off while dining or drinking at their table. But if they get up to walk around, or go to the restroom, they should put the mask back on.
- Our team will not serve anyone who is not wearing a mask. We will have disposable masks for those who come and don't have one. If the guests will not comply, we will ask the guest to leave the premises.

In addition, Governor Greg Abbott issued an executive order Friday morning, limiting certain businesses and services as an effort to contain the spread of COVID-19.

The order includes the following:

- Restaurants may remain open for dine-in service, but at a capacity not to exceed 50% of total listed indoor occupancy, beginning Monday, June 29, 2020.
- Outdoor gatherings of 100 or more people must be approved by local governments, with certain exceptions

In addition, all guests, suppliers, employees and vendors who have tested positive and/or those awaiting Covid-19 test results are not allowed on site. We trust all individuals will be responsible and do the right thing to keep everyone safe.
